With its debut flight on February 14, 1989, the Delta II carried on the long legacy of Delta mission success dating back to 1960. The Delta II quickly established itself as the preeminent leader in the medium class market and gained the affectionate nickname "The Industry Workhouse." Launching from Complex 17 at Cape Canaveral Air Force Station and SLC-2W at Vandenberg AFB, Delta II has faithfully launched over 150 critical missions for NASA, USAF, and commercial customers.

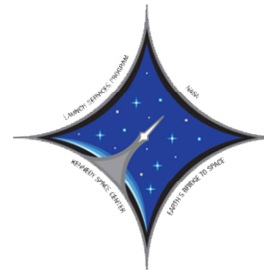
